Baltimore County Department of Health to Hold Additional Appointment Only H1N1 Vaccination Clinics

WHAT

The Baltimore County Department of Health will hold additional appointment only H1N1 vaccination clinics for those in the priority group. Call 410-887-BCHD (2243) TODAY until 7 pm and between the hours of 9 am – 3 pm for the remainder of the week to make an appointment. The clinic address will be given to you along with your appointment time.

The following priority populations can receive the H1N1 vaccine at these clinics:

- Pregnant women
- Household contacts and caregivers of children under 6 months old
- Healthcare workers and Emergency Medical Services personnel
- Children and young adults aged 6 months to 24 years
- Persons aged 25-64 with health conditions that place them at greater risk of influenza complications

These clinics are by appointment only. You will not receive a vaccination without an appointment.

- Tuesday, November 3rd from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Thursday, November 5th from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Friday, November 6th from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
*This clinic is **for healthy children and adults 2 to 24 years of age**. Only intranasal (mist) vaccine will be given.*
