Visiting Team Buses:

Visiting team buses are asked to conduct drop off by entering the bus loop off of Hiss Ave. Stop at the first entrance marked by the flag poles. Enter the doors and direct athletes to proceed directly into the gymnasium.

Visiting Fans:


Visiting fans are permitted to park in the school's main lot off of Avondale Road. Additional street parking may be found along Hiss Ave and Avondale Road. Please do not block access to any residential driveways or homes.

Admission:

All tickets must be purchased online using Hometown Ticketing. No tickets will be sold at the door. Tickets will go on sale 24 hours before the start of the first game. Ticket sales are limited, and are sold on a first come, first serve basis. All student/child spectators must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) or they will not be admitted to the gymnasium. The designated adult must stay with the child throughout the entirety of the event and provide transportation for them after the event concludes.

Safety:

- Per BCPS policy, no bags are permitted in the gym and must be left in the designated bag area. An exception will be made for medically necessary items, diaper bags, and small purses (4.5"x6.5"). Parkville Middle School is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Once spectators have entered the gym, there is no readmittance if they choose to leave before the game has ended.
- Loitering on school grounds at the conclusion of the event is not permitted.
- Unsportsmanlike behavior from athletes and spectators is not tolerated. This may result in removal from the event at the discretion of game officials and/or school administration.
- All games are staffed with an EMT, Baltimore County Police Officer, and chaperone volunteers.
